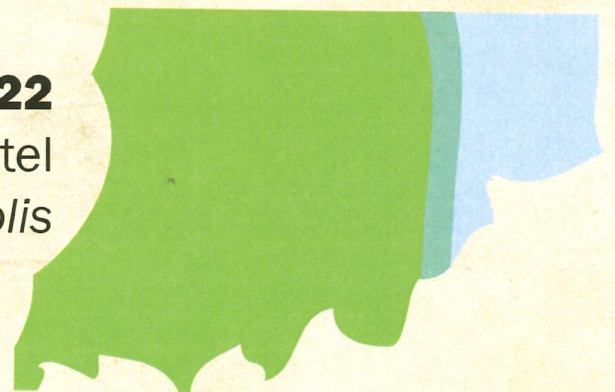

Implementation**

- MS4 operator must develop measurable goals and implement a public education, outreach, and participation and involvement program that must include strategies to inform identified constituent groups about the impacts of stormwater run-off.
- MS4 entities renewing permit coverage must assess program requirements and goals from the previous permit, modify as necessary, and implement the requirements of this permit. MS4 entity, at a minimum must develop and implement a strategy to achieve the requirements within specific deadlines as outlined in this permit.

- MS4 operator must develop and administer a comprehensive pollution prevention and good housekeeping program. The program must include a commitment to prevent or reduce pollutant run-off from MS4 owned and/or operated facilities.
- MS4 entities renewing permit coverage must assess program requirements and goals from the previous permit, modify as necessary, and implement the requirements of this permit.

**IDDE - Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination (MCM 3)
Program Requirements & Program Implementation**

- MS4 operator must develop an IDDE program to detect, address, and eliminate illicit discharges into the MS4 conveyance system.
- The program does not need to address the categories of non-stormwater discharges or flows as identified in Section 1.2 of the permit unless IDEM or the MS4 operator identifies them as significant contributors of pollutants into the MS4 conveyance system.
- MS4 entities renewing permit coverage must assess program requirements and goals from the previous permit, modify as necessary, and implement the requirements of this permit.
